The school believes that PLAY is an essential tool in learning. We shall be having a lot of games and moving around in the coming days and months. In this regard, the school puts equal emphasis on the safety of the children. We confine our activities in the school premises except for once or twice a year when we go out on educational trips. Likewise, children are taught to distinguish what is right from what is wrong, what is dangerous and harmful from what is safe and to understand the consequences of their actions. There are times when the teachers have to assert their authority in order to instill order and proper behavior. So occasionally, we give "time-outs" to children who get "uncontrollable". In such cases, we see to it that the child understands why he gets such "time out".

However, children will be children and some accidents happen beyond the control of the school. Accidents like bumping, stumbling and getting bruises are sometimes unavoidable and of course we go out of our way to help or to comfort the child.

We hope that we could join hands in making the children's early learning experience rich and meaningful.
